Human Capital Empowerment in Myanmar (HCEM) A Full Scholarship Exclusively for Myanmar Students

- Through the Norwegian Embassy Based in Yangon, the Republic of the Union of Myanmar, the Norwegian government provides scholarships to students from the Republic of the Union of Myanmar to pursue studies at the bachelor's degree level at Mahidol University.
- **This initiation (four-year degree) was launched in 2024 under the project “Human Capital Empowerment in Myanmar (HCEM).” It is a Co-payment Scholarship in collaboration between the Norwegian Government and Mahidol University.**
- **The Norwegian Government supports up to 70% of tuition fees and other relevant expenses, and Mahidol University, through participating study programs, supports the remaining 30% of the tuition fee.**

Only 4 Undergraduate International Programs and 8 Scholarships (2 students from each program) are fully supported and offered by the Faculty of Science

The scholarship supports different items

Supported by the Norwegian Government

- **70% of tuition fee**
- **Necessary expenses such as health insurance, etc.**
- **Landing payment of 20,000 THB; pay once upon arrival.**
- **Monthly allowances of 10,000 THB per month (5,000 THB during student taking leave to home country).**

Supported by the Participating Programs

- **30% of tuition fee**

This payment amount will be supported along with the required registered subjects and the program's structure officially announced by Mahidol University.

Total study period supported by the scholarship

The scholarship recipients will receive funding per the curriculum requirements (4 years of continuing education).

If the scholarship recipient terminates the study or the student status is ended upon receiving the scholarship, the scholarship will be terminated immediately.



A contract to receive the scholarship is required between Mahidol University, the Study Program, and the student.

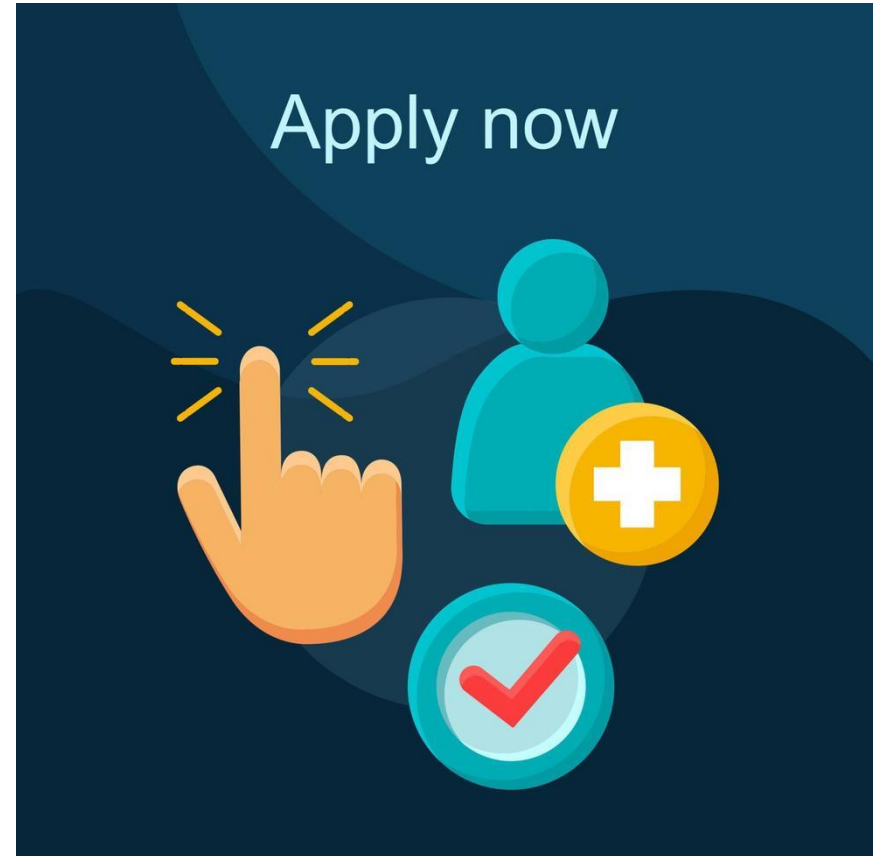
What is the procedure for the payment?

- **The landing payment will be paid directly to the student per the given bank account upon arrival.**
- **The monthly allowances will be paid directly to the student per the given bank account within the 25th day of each month.**
- **Tuition fee: The involved MU's divisions will process the tuition fees and other fees directly per Mahidol University requirements (invoice).**
- **Monthly allowances that have already been transferred to students each month must be returned to MU in case those students later decide to travel abroad or to their home country in that month.**



Who can apply for this scholarship?

- **Myanmar nationality**
- **The applicant must be qualified per each study program's qualification requirements.**
- **Transferred students from other universities or abroad are not applicable.**
- **Must be a newly enrolled student for this academic year (2024)**
- **It does not apply to students enrolled in previous years.**
